

Prodigi Privacy Statement

Digital Connections DBA Prodigi (collectively referred to as “Prodigi”) is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you a safe on-line experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to Prodigi’s websites and governs data collection and usage. By using the Prodigi websites, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of Personal Information

Prodigi collects personally identifiable information, such as your email address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Prodigi also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

Information about your computer hardware and software is also automatically collected by Prodigi. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used by Citizens for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Prodigi websites.

Please keep in mind that if you directly disclose personally identifiable information or personally sensitive data through Prodigi’s Public message boards, this information may be collected and used by others. Note: Prodigi does not read any of your private online communications.

Prodigi encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link from Prodigi so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Prodigi is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Prodigi website family.

Use of Personal Information

Prodigi collects and uses your personal information to operate the Prodigi websites and deliver the services you have requested. Prodigi also uses your personally identifiable information to

inform you of other products or services available from Prodigy and its affiliates. Prodigy may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Prodigy does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Prodigy may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In most cases, your unique personally identifiable information (email, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third part. In addition, Prodigy may share data, with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or post mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Prodigy, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Prodigy does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Prodigy keeps track of websites and pages our customers visit within Prodigy, in order to determine what Prodigy services are most popular. This date is used to deliver customized content and advertising withing Prodigy to customers whose behavior indicates they are interested in a particular subject area.

Prodigy websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) confirm the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Prodigy's site; (b) protect and defend the personal safety of users of Prodigy, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Prodigy websites use "cookies" to help you personalize your on-line experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a webpage server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issues the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Prodigy pages, or register with Prodigy's site or services, a cookie helps Prodigy to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Prodigy website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Prodigy features you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Prodigy services or websites you visit.

Security of Personal Information

Prodigy secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. Prodigy secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, and use or disclosure. When personal information (such as credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

Changes to this Statement

Prodigy will occasionally update this statement of privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. Prodigy encourages you to periodically review this statement to be informed of how Prodigy is protecting your information.
